

# exercise :: 03

## Creating Mock Web Sites

### Overview ::

Using the provided site map, create a Local Root Folder and the file structure for a mock Web site. Starting from the home page, create links to each HTML page in the site. You do not need to worry about the visual presentation of these links, just create appropriately labeled, functioning text links. These links, when finished, should appear on every page in the site. In the end, you should have a complete, functional Web site.

### Steps ::

1. Prepare your Local Root Folder and files:
  - o Make sure that your folder for this class is on your computer's Desktop. Copy the Homework\_Resources\_03 folder to your computer, and rename one of the folders with your full name plus the exercise number (lastname\_firstname\_03). This will become your Local Root Folder for this exercise.
  - o In the resources folder is a folder called Source Files that contains all of the files you will need to complete this exercise.
  - o Copy the provided MOCK\_SITE\_TEMPLATE.html to the lastname\_firstname\_03 folder. Create empty versions of all of the required pages by duplicating (Command-D in the Mac OS X Finder) the provided HTML document, and rename the new files appropriately.
2. Define a Dreamweaver Site using the lastname\_firstname\_03 folder as your **Local Root Folder**. This is required before you can continue with this exercise.
3. Create all of the necessary navigation links on the **home page only**, including links to the four anchors on the Activities page.
4. Once your links work on the home page, copy and paste the links to the other pages of the site. Dreamweaver will take care of maintaining the links across pages.
5. Add content to the following pages:
  - o The **Activities** page requires Named Anchors. Copy the sample text from the sample\_text.html and create anchors just before each of the Activity headers. Create text links below the H1 page header to each of the anchors on the page.
  - o On the **Experiences** page, use the provided photo (john\_day\_river.jpg) and create a rectangular Image Map link above the text to Fishing section of the Activities page.
  - o On the **Activity Leaders** page, add this text: "Get a hold of Jungle Joe via the Contact Us page.". Create a server-relative link to the Contact Us page for the underlined text only.
  - o The **Outdoor Links** page contains three absolute links. Add these as plain text links.
  - o The **Contact Us** page requires three e-mail links. Add these addresses as text links.
  - o For each page, add meaningful titles to both the HTML Title (Modify > Page Properties > Title/Encoding > Title field) and the page itself (use the provided H1 tag).

6. Preview the site in a Web browser. You should be able to navigate site easily, with every page containing links to the other pages in the mock site.
7. When done, upload the `lastname_firstname_03` folder to your space on the CCCVC Web server. TO do this, it might be easier for you to copy the `lastname_firstname_03` folder to your main VC 237 Local Root Folder, then upload it to the server using Dreamweaver.
8. When uploaded, test your site by viewing it on the live class web server:  
`www.cccvc.com/vc237/your_folder/lastname_firstname_03/`.
