**Mission Statement**

**Programs Offered**

**Advance EMT-Hybrid**

The AEMT course is a limited enrollment program for course EMT168. The AEMT course starts Winter term. Students must apply for admission. Clinical rotations in hospitals and with ambulance services provide hands-on EMS experience. Didactic information is delivered in a hybrid fashion that involves live online lectures, face-to-face interactions, and intense lab skill practice (Mandatory face-to-face sessions will be orientation, occasional lecture, and Saturday labs. Most lectures on-line on Tuesday and Thursday Evenings. Occasional Open labs on Sundays.) Successful completion qualifies the student to take the State of Oregon and/or National Registry examinations for licensure as an Advance EMT.

**Who is Eligible to Apply**

The Advance EMT is a limited entry enrollment with an average of 24 students each cohort. The program accepts students in Winter term. Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for a position in the class:

1. Applicant must be licensed as an Oregon EMT with good standings.
2. Currently employed or volunteering with an EMS agency and/or health care facility (ex. Hospital, clinic, or urgent care).
3. Current AHA BLS card with expiration that is not before June of the course year.
4. Letter of recommendation from a current supervisor and/or training officer that is able to speak to your character and the ability to support your success.
5. Current driver license that is valid
6. Current high school diploma or equivalent
7. All vaccination current and/or completed prior to the first day of Winter term per Chemeketa requirements (See attached form).

**Admission Prioritization**

The following will be considered when selecting and prioritizing applicants for the program.

1. Completion of admission application packet (your packet will be evaluated for completeness, compliance, and ability to follow directions
2. Completed vaccinations upon application due date.
3. AHA BLS card with acceptable expiration date
4. Work history
5. Endorsement Letter from EMS Chief/CEO/Chief

## Estimated Program Cost

This is an estimated cost of the Advance EMT. For more complete breakdown of cost, you are welcome to inquire with faculty. Please be aware this is an estimate and the actual cost per individual may vary depending on several factors.

- AEMT Tuition (\$91 per credits, \$24 fee=\$115 per credit): \$920.00 (Subject to change)
- CTE Class Fee: \$10 per credit: \$80 (Subject to change)
- AEMT Lab fees: \$540.00 (Subject to change 2020-2021)
- AEMT textbooks (variable): \$70.00-\$100.00 per term (Charged upon admission. Candidate may not opt opt of this fee.
- Vaccination cost (variable on needs): \$1100.00
- Uniform/PPE equipment/Physical (variable): \$400.00

**Estimated Total: \$3040.00**

**After course completion cost: *These fees are not included with the program cost***

- State licensure: \$165.00
- National Written Exam (Pearson Vue): \$110.00
- National Practical exam (variable on location): \$50.00-\$200.00
